The Isles of Shoals Association scholarship grant funds are intended to provide need-based financial aid to Star Island conference attendees who may not otherwise be able to attend a conference. All scholarship funding provided by the ISA grant program should be allocated through an open and fair process that is accessible to all conferees. If you are requesting scholarship funds please include information about your conference's scholarship promotion, application, and review processes.

Funds granted for the 2010 Conference season are available until October 15, 2010. Funds not used for the stated purpose should be returned to the ISA Treasurer. For Conferences to receive funds in advance a Tax ID# must be provided. Conferences without tax ID numbers will receive reimbursement after receipts have been received. Further information will be provided with grant approval notification.
